**BRUSH – LEAVES – YARD WASTE**

- ❖ Curbside branch collection is offered to residents every Monday in the Village of Fredonia (weather permitting). When placing branches curbside for pick-up, please put cut ends toward the curb. Branches should be laying next to each other; not criss-crossing. The maximum diameter accepted is 6". Failure to comply with these rules may result in branches not being picked up. You will need to call the village office at 692-9125 prior to 7 a.m. Monday morning to arrange for this service. **Branch drop-off is not allowed at the WWTP site.** Wood chips are available to the public as supply permits.
- ❖ Leaves and yard debris may be put on the compost pile at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. If you use plastic bags to transport your yard waste, be sure to take the bags along with you.
- ❖ Open burning of grass and leaves is prohibited in the village.
- ❖ In Fall, the Village of Fredonia does offer curbside collection of leaves on Tuesdays as a service for Village residents. Actual dates will be posted in the What's New Section of our website. Please be sure to keep raked leaves away from the catch basins. Village ordinance allows leaves to be raked to the curb up to 72 hours before a scheduled curbside pick-up.
